

## LITTLE BRITAIN TOWNSHIP ZONING HEARING MINUTES

The Little Britain Township Zoning Board held their annual Organizational Meeting on Wednesday, January 15, 2020. A Chairperson and Vice Chairperson was being voted on. Ms. Joan Deen, was reappointed Chairperson, and Larry Burkhart was chosen as the Vice Chairperson. The board unanimously agreed on the choices.

Ms. Deen called the meeting to order at 7:05PM. Neil Albert, Attorney proceeded with announcing to the attendants how the meeting was going to be held.

1. The first applicant was Mr. Aaron Stoltzfus, 49 Green Lane, Nottingham, PA who was requesting a Special Exception under section 201.3B. The request was for a 16X24' portable horse barn and one additional horse. The Bd. Of Supervisors noted without comment, the Planning Comm. Abstained from recommending approval of the application. The Zoning Board approved the application as written.
2. Mr. Israel Kinsinger, 286 Reath Rd., Kirkwood, PA was requesting a Variance for approval to construct a 34X46' bldg. for refrigerated storage; also, an 8X15 breezeway from the existing plant to the proposed building. A request for relief from final plan date, under section 607.4. Approval of one year to complete project was initiated.  
The Planning Comm recommended approval of application. The Bd. Of Supervisors approved without comment. The Zoning Bd. Recommended approval as presented.
